



ONSITE SERVICES

Forensic Examiners can be dispatched 24X7 to perform the following services:

- Coordinate with the Client to secure and preserve evidence
- Identify additional devices and media to be collected
- Photograph and diagram the scene if necessary
- Comprehensively document hardware and software present
- Determine if malicious processes are occurring which may be damaging evidence
- Verify the integrity of evidence to be collected and ensure no modification occurs
- Interview persons of interest regarding items to be collected
- Perform live memory acquisition on demand
- Perform onsite imaging of hard disks and other media as conditions permit
- Document and prepare components for transportation and storage

All investigators are trained in conducting onsite examinations and implementing chain of custody protocols compliant with US Department of Justice guidelines.

When evidence is part of a legitimate business enterprise, examiners may be required to image drives onsite. The original drive must be retained and a working duplicate is typically left in its place to avoid issues relating to the disruption of business continuity. A civil case can quickly become a criminal case and vice versa; so all acquisitions are executed as if the case were criminal in nature to ensure later admissibility of evidence.

Examiners can perform many kinds of information recovery locally and can save recovered materials to a variety of media from DVDs to USB thumb drives. Reports are generally not generated for simple file recoveries unless specifically requested.

Live memory acquisition assumes that the machine is powered on when the Examiner arrives and that there is no password-protected screen-saver activated. It is important to note that this is an emerging technique that may reveal additional information about the running state of a device that would otherwise be difficult to recreate from a hard disk image.

After evidence has been preserved for transportation the Examiner will notify the Client and wait for additional instructions.

Examiners will deploy with a Digital Intelligence F.R.E.D.L. Mobile Field Acquisition Kit and all materials required to safely and securely transport devices and data privately and confidentially.
